PREPARATION OF THE WORKING EXPERIENCE REPORT

The working experience report is intended to assist the Society in assessing the quality and the extent of the practical experience of the applicant. It is therefore important that it follows the format prescribed below.

CONTENTS

The report must describe the candidate's own engineering activities and not the functions of the sections or divisions where he has worked. The report should be divided into the following sections. Title, Summary, Content, Introduction, and Body of the Report. The body of the report should consist of at least six sections chosen from

- ❖ Process Plant Development
- ❖ Process Plant Operation
- ❖ Process Plant and Equipment Design
- ❖ Process and Plant Evaluation
- ❖ Process and Plant Fabrication Materials of Construction
- ❖ Administration and Management
- ❖ Technical sales, Marketing and Contract Negotiation
- ❖ Chemical Engineering Research
- ❖ Teaching of Chemical Engineering
- ❖ Control and Instrumentation
- ❖ Quality Control
- ❖ Computer application
- ❖ Health and Safety

The candidate is free to include some topics that have not been listed here.

PRESENTATION

The report should not be longer than 2000 words. It should be typed on A4 paper with sufficient margins. It should be signed by the candidate and attested to by his current boss. The attester should state his designation. Two copies of the report should accompany the candidate's application form.
